



LET'S HELP THE RODRIGUEZ FAMILY AFTER TRAGIC ACCIDENT ON THE I495

My name is Angela Ruiz, and I am the sister of Manuel Rodriguez. I am writing this with a heavy heart to share what happened to my brother and his family this past Saturday night.

While driving home, Manuel and his wife Maria were rear-ended by a speeding and distracted driver going an estimated 120 miles per hour on I-495. The impact was catastrophic. They were rushed to Plainview Hospital, where they both underwent emergency surgeries and will need more in the weeks ahead.

Manuel's injuries are severe — he suffered a broken femur, multiple fractured ribs, and a collapsed lung. He remains in serious condition and faces a long recovery. Maria was also badly hurt, sustaining a fractured pelvis, a severe concussion, and several spinal fractures. She too is recovering from surgery, with additional procedures expected.

Thankfully, their young son Manny was not in the car at the time of the crash. While we are grateful for that, the road ahead for Manuel and Maria will be incredibly difficult. With both unable to work, they face mounting medical bills on top of everyday living expenses. Our family is doing everything we can to support them, but we cannot do this alone.
