



HELP KEN (GUNNER) RECOVER AFTER HIS SERIOUS MOTORCYCLE ACCIDENT

At HelpVy, we have the privilege of hearing many stories of resilience. Ken "Gunner" Murray's story is one that reminds us how quickly life can change.

On **Tuesday, July 7, 2026**, Ken was riding home after a job interview, excited to begin a new chapter after being offered a new job. Tragically, that excitement turned into heartbreak in an instant.

While traveling on Highway 242, a medical supply van merged into Ken's lane and struck his motorcycle. According to reports, the driver was on a cell phone at the time of the collision.

Ken was rushed to the hospital, where he remains today.

His injuries are extensive. Ken suffered a **crushed right foot, torn ligaments in his right knee, torn tendons in his right ankle, multiple broken ribs, a concussion**, and severe **road rash** along the right side of his body and both of his swollen hands.

Doctors have explained that the injuries to Ken's right foot and ankle are exceptionally complex—the type of injuries more commonly seen in professional athletes. He will require **multiple surgeries**, and his recovery is expected to be long and challenging.

Before this accident, Ken proudly served our country as a **United States Marine**, including humanitarian missions throughout the Pacific, where he dedicated himself to helping others in need. That spirit of service has continued throughout his life. Friends and family describe Ken as someone who is always the first to help others and the last person to ask for help himself.

Today, Ken needs our help.

The funds raised will help cover **medical expenses** and **everyday living expenses** while he focuses on surgeries, rehabilitation, and the long journey back to recovery.
